Thanks to the Creator, on the evening of August 26, 2019, after I gave a 12 min presentation on the ethnohistory of the name "Cheroenhaka" and the name "Cattashowrock" as they apply to the Cheroenhaka (Nottoway) Indian Tribe of Southampton County VA; to include, when and where these name appeared in the annuals of Colonial History, I made the following recommendations, including the reasons for said recommendations:

1. that the current Route 742 that flows from Hwy 58, toward our tribal land, around the two round abouts to the Nottoway River be named "Cheroenhaka Road"

2. and the paved road ending at the entrance to Cattashowrock Trail be named "Cattashowrock Drive."

I am happy to inform the Tribal Council, tribal members and the Board Members of the Cheroenhaka (Nottoway) Tribe Heritage Foundation that my recommendations were fully accepted by all members of the Southampton County Board of Supervisors resulting in a motion by said Board and a unanimous vote that the roads be name as recommended.

This is another strong feather in the hat of the tribe and a historical moment that these roads will now bear the names of our tribe.

Would like to thank Vice Chief Ellis Wright for being there supporting the tribe and my presentation.

Since this is a critical moment in the history of the 17 year plight of our tribe (since reorganization in 2002) I am recommending that the tribal secretary record this email as separate minutes for the tribe effective August 26, 2919.

These minutes will be used as an enclosure to our Federal Recognition packet.
