- o Robert Turner Chief Brown and Rickie Boone have been cutting grass Kudos for all their hard work
- Chief Brown thanks the grant committee for jumping on the Hampton Foundation grant for the restoration of our tribal village.
 - NOA will be in mid-December with funding released in January
- o Tribal Village need repair and set up for the School Day -
 - Tribal Workday email will be sent to all tribal members.
- **Fall School Book Scholarships**, six students, (\$300 Mail to Each by FD Treasurer)-Thank you letter status?
 - o Beverly El reports receiving thank you letters from all six recipients
- Need large donations tax exempt letters sent out on the FD Letterhead to the Hampton Roads Community Foundation for the \$3,000 & \$5,000 donation to our FD tribal land and after upcoming tribal speaking engagement presentation.

 - New Straw Bales around the inside Powwow Circle and Village

 - Must be on site at 8:30am on November 4, 2022
 More information to follow.
- Chief is Expecting at minimum 500 children
 - Powwow Color Guard
 - A Company 244th QM BN. 23rd QM BDE Fort Lee, VA
 - a. They will carry in the US Flag, All Services Flag, POW Flag and Battalion Flag (They will not post colors)
 - b. Tribe will carry in the Eagle Staff, Tribal Flag and Tribal US Flag (will post colors)
 - Iroquoian Native American Wedding, 3 pm, November 5, 2022
 - Chief found and read his letter stating he was ordained to perform tribal weddings
 - Need tribal women to carry in the bread and a tribal man to carry in the arrow.
 - Need two blue blankets on one white blanket (purchased by Rebecca Sutaris)

- a. The man and the woman will be wrapped individually in a blue blanket when entering the circle –
- b. At a point doing the ceremony they both will be wrapped together in a white blanket
- c. Need a tribal woman to carry in the white blanket
- d. Need four (4) small pebbles Red, Brown, White and Blue
- Chief Brown to send email with possible tribal member names for the above stations for the tribal wedding

- Kitchen Update

- o Cashiers, Saturday: Dianna Faison and Gary Burnette
- o Cashiers for Sunday Still needed 3-4
 - Carolyn Brown is volunteering to help on Sunday
- o Needs assistance in cooking ahead of time; 50-60lbs of bison meat for frybread
 - Dianna Faison and Tommy Birchett (?) to assist with pre-cooking
 - Michael Skipper handling the frybread booth Saturday and Sunday (approximately 350 frybread sold last November 2-day powwow)
 - Needs help with the french-fry station one person to man 2 fry pots and double burner for french fries
 - Tommy Birchett has volunteered to help with food purchase
 - Collette Amici will be manning and leading kitchen on Sunday since Gary Burnette will not be available
 - Still looking for inside kitchen help currently has one of the Orie girls
 - Need to find all square readers, Chief ask that Caroh Holley reach out to Foundation Treasurer Kitty Boone to locate other readers.
 - Chief saying, he will try to find other volunteers via phone and email
 - Bernard Wright volunteering his grand children to assist in kitchen, Chief Brown ask him to call him directly.
 - Chief Brown asking Tommy Hines (Assistant Treasurer) to sit with Dianna Faison on Sunday to take credit card sales for kitchen
